The Spoon River College Adult Education and Family Literacy (AEFL) Program is committed to build and expand opportunities for high school equivalency students to transition into college and the workforce. Beyond preparation for the high school equivalency exam or improving English language skills, the AEFL program is dedicated to building on the pathways created to assist students to obtain or improve their employment options and successfully enroll and complete post-secondary education. Spoon River College AEFL serves 4 counties: Fulton, Mason, McDonough, and Schuyler.

High School Equivalency: All incoming students must complete a TABE assessment to enroll.

- Classes offered at all four Spoon River College sites
- Classes offered in the morning and evening.
- Classes are typically two days per week.
 - o Spoon River College will pay for GED Test (\$120 value) for qualified students.
 - o Students who meet specific qualifications may enroll in a Career Link program in which cash based incentives can be earned

Bridge Program: The programs offers two programs that blend HSE skills with a career focus. All incoming students must score a 6th grade reading level or above on the TABE assessment to qualify.

- Two Bridge Programs offered during the day
 - o Career Pathways
 - o Healthcare Bridge

English as a Second Language: All incoming students are required to complete a BEST Plus oral test to qualify.

Classes are offered at the Macomb and Rushville sites.
